
'Yoga Day' witnessing different yoga asanas performed by all the students for better concentration and meditation.



It is with immense pleasure and pride that I share the incredible achievements of our students in the **Science Olympiad Foundation Exams**. Over 500 enthusiastic students from grades 1 to 9 participated across a wide

array of subjects with many earning gold medals for their outstanding performances. Notably, **Bhavya Agarval** from grade 6 achieved a prestigious gold medal, securing an impressive regional and national rank of 7 in the International Mathematics Olympiad (IMO). In Science Olympiad(NSO), we celebrate **Smeeral S of grade 2**, who earned a gold medal with an exceptional international rank of 8, and **Kanav M** from grade 3, who also clinched a gold with an international rank of 18. **Annirudh Hadimani** of grade 6 further showcased excellence, securing a gold medal with an international rank of 17. In the International English Olympiad (IEO), **Thrishv Gopi** from grade 4A achieved an outstanding international rank of 10. Moreover, I am thrilled to announce that 66 of our talented students have qualified for the second level exams, a testament to their dedication and hard work.
